



COVID-19 Preschool Policies Oct 2020

The following policies are in addition to those in your Parent Handbook and will be updated as new information becomes available. Where these policies are in conflict with the Parent Handbook, these policies will apply. Please refer to this page and your handbook often. Let's work together to stay safe!

- The following assessment must be done daily at home prior to coming to Preschool: My child does not have any of the following symptoms:

Fever	Cough
Headache	Body/Muscle Aches
Sore Throat	Chills
Runny Nose	Nasal Congestion
Conjunctivitis	Dizziness
Fatigue	Nausea/Vomiting
Diarrhea	Loss of Appetite
Loss of taste or smell	Rash
Shortness of Breath	

- Parents are required to wear a mask for drop off and pick up. Children are not required to wear masks. If siblings must attend drop off and pick up they must stay close to the parent.
- Only one parent/guardian to drop off and pick up children. Preferably the same person each time.
- Please arrive **no more than 10 minutes** before class time and adhere to directional, spacing, and safety signage in the hallways and washrooms.
- Before entering the classroom, parents will take the child to use the toilet and wash hands for 20 seconds.
- Hand Sanitizer will be used in the classroom.



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- Teachers may choose to wear masks when distancing is less possible, and will wear them for art and singing when distancing is not possible.
- Each class is its own pod. Classroom and washroom will be cleaned and sanitized between classes. Each class will have its own set of toys.
- Each child will have individual school supplies and sensory items stored separately.
- Snack will occur in a separate classroom to provide distancing. Children must be able to open and close their own snacks. Hands will be washed before eating and sanitized after eating.
- Indoor shoes and all locker belongings will go back and forth each day with your child.
- Please call the Preschool Office at 306-373-5445 extension 235 with admin. questions. Please email preschool@cdac.ca to report all absences. Use extension 236 if you need to reach the classroom.
- Parent, or Emergency Contact must be available at any time to pick up their child if they become ill.
- Children are expected to be **free of any symptoms for at least 48 hours** before returning to Preschool.
- We kindly ask families to socialize safely outside of our building and entrance ways.
