



PROCEDURES USED FOR ILLNESS OR WHEN COVID IS SUSPECTED

If your child is ill

1. Keep your child at home until they are symptom free for at least 48 hours.
2. Call 8-1-1 if they are not getting better. Tell them your child attends Preschool, and proceed with their instructions.

If a child is exhibiting symptoms of COVID while at Preschool

1. The child will be isolated in the Story Pit Area.
2. Parent will be called for immediate pick up.
3. Parent must call 8-1-1 (tell them your child attends Preschool) and proceed with instructions (either to go for testing, self-isolate, or self-monitor). Child must stay home until they are symptom free for at least 48 hours.
4. Toys and furnishings from that class group will be sanitized.
5. If the child is negative, no action will be taken.
6. If child is positive, the Preschool will contact 8-1-1 for directions on how to proceed.
7. School will continue.
8. Child will not return to school until they have been cleared by Sask. Public Health.
9. If there are two or more positive cases the Preschool class impacted will close for fourteen days unless otherwise informed by Sask. Public Health.

If a case of COVID is reported from a Parent to the Preschool

1. Proceed with #4 and #6 onward.
